Free Swim Testing Day

If you're not sure what class to place your child in, come to the City Pool on Saturday, June 19, 2010 between 10:00 – Noon. Our qualified staff will assess your child and recommend a class.

Swimming Lessons

Only a few more days of registration at the Community Center. On Saturday, June 19, 2010 sign ups will move to the City Pool. (One advantage of signing up at the Community Center is the added option to pay for lessons with a credit/debit card.)

We have classes for all ages and abilities. Group and private lessons are available. Come in to find out times and availability. Sessions are ½ hour a day for 2 weeks. First session starts June 21, 2010.

Private Lessons: \$60

Group Lessons: \$40

Jr. Lifeguard Class

This is a 4-week program that is designed to introduce safety skills and rescue techniques required to become a lifeguard. This class does not certify, but rather prepares future guards. Fee includes a t-shirt, certificate of completion, and free pool entry during program. Open to boys and girls ages 12-15. This program runs July 5 – 30, 2010.
