In an effort to strengthen our community partnerships and enhance public trust, the Reedley Police Department has implemented two (2) new “TIP Line” numbers for the public to call in tips or specific information regarding criminal activity. These types of calls could be related to ongoing drug activity, gang activity, other criminal related conduct or “quality of life” issues that the public would like to report. These “tips” can now be called in telephonically through two (2) separate phone numbers, one for English speaking citizens and one for Spanish speaking citizens. We will not be implementing “Text Tips” at this time, but will be looking at the possibility of adding that enhanced feature in the future.

The goal through the new TIP reporting process will be to provide the public an opportunity, 24 hours a day, to call in all types of activity while also remaining anonymous if they choose. The Police Department would like to inform the public that if you need an immediate response by the Police for an activity that is in progress or any type of emergency situation, please call 911.

Although callers on the “tip” line can remain anonymous, the department would encourage callers to leave a name and number to be potentially re-contacted by a member of the Police Department to gain further information. The Department understands the need in certain situations to remain anonymous, and we will make every effort in those situations to keep the caller’s information confidential.
